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WORKSHOP LEADERS

Ben has been a Professional Actor and Public Speaking Coach since graduating from the world-renowned drama school, Bristol Old Vic Theatre School, in July 2008. He trained in all forms of theatre ranging from classical Theatre to Contemporary Theatre, Screen, Radio, Stage and Combat & Voice. Ben has gone on to perform professionally on stage and screen for many companies including the Royal Shakespeare Company, The Watermill Theatre, BBC Television, ITV, BBC Radio 4.

Ben also works as a freelance Acting Tutor & Public Speaking Coach for many schools, businesses & organisation and as the lead Public Speaking Practitioner on the National Citizen Service (NCS) programme for children aged 15-18; helping people with confidence, how to hold and engage an audience, and to develop and enhance confidence skills and those all-important performance and communication skills. Ben is used to working with students aged 9 and above both in person and via Zoom. He has online safeguarding policy, a valid DBS certificate as well as Public Liability insurance.

Harry has been working in the world of Performing Arts for over 15 years: as a lead vocalist, children's songwriter and performing arts teacher. He sang in the Mark Tait Band for 10 years: performing at weddings, private functions and parties across the country and now sings Swing and Jazz songs as a solo act in local restaurants, care homes and at private parties. In 2013 he came second in a UK nationwide search for a new Neighbours theme tune singer and also sang in a One Direction Tribute Band touring the UK that year.

In 2014, Harry created The Performers Club to provide extra-curricular opportunities for children to experience Performing Arts and increase their confidence and self-esteem. Over the past 7 years he has worked with hundreds of children, teaching them a mixture of Musical Theatre and Pop songs, leading up to end of term showcases to parents and friends.

Harry also writes children's songs for his You Tube channel Elm Tree Town and has received over 300k views. These original songs are a mixture of sing-alongs, lullabies and special themed occasions; including Christmas and Halloween. On the channel you will find songs suitable for toddlers and pre-school, through to primary school age.
